DAY 1 – SATURDAY 14 SEPTEMBER

Day 1, location 1- The Granary, Quay Lane, CO10 2AN – STARTING POINT

As in previous years, there is NO CAR PARKING at the Granary on Saturday morning due to lack of space.

- Friday (5pm-9.30pm) You are able to drop off craft for overnight and secure storage (subject to available space) – you could pitch your tent at Rushbanks Friday night to save the task of erecting it when you arrive on Saturday (£7.50 for unoccupied pitch)!
- Registration (8am-10.30am)
- Checkpoint & Departure (8.30am-10.30am)

Directions from Sudbury town centre: follow the signs to the Quay Theatre. You can also walk from the long stay car park near the Kingfisher Leisure Centre (see map below).



The nearest long stay car park is at Station Road Car Park (also known as Kingfisher Car Park due to its proximity of the Kingfisher Leisure Centre). Details as below or more information at:

- Maximum Stay: 24 to 72 hours (paid tickets) and 3 hours (free tickets) during ticketing hours, otherwise 24 hours. No return within 4 hours.

- Tariff (no charge for disabled persons, provided that a valid blue badge is on display): Up to 3 hours – FREE / 24 hours - $\pounds 2$ / 48 hours - $\pounds 4$ / 72 hours - $\pounds 6$

- Payment Type: Coins (at ticket machine) or credit/debit card (via *RingGo* - location code 2537) <u>**OR**</u> park in the Anglia Adventures compound at the end at Cattawade until Sunday (open 5pm - dusk on Fri, and 7.30 - 10am on Sat). Directions to the Anglia Adventures site: Postcode C011 1QR gets participants close to the industrial estate, need to continue towards Manningtree and look for wooden gates on a road corner with an S2C sign.

Directions from Sudbury: follow the A134 towards Colchester through Leavenheath. Coming down a steep hill towards Nayland take a right turn marked Bures and Wissington (Nags Corner) the campsite is 1 mile up on the left and will be well signed.

SHUTTLE SERVICE to Anchor Inn

- A 16-seater mini bus will operate during the evening between the campsite and Anchor, Nayland.
- First trip from campsite at 6.30pm, then approx. every 25 mins until last bus back at 10.30pm.
- ANYONE DEEMED OVER THE ALCOHOL LIMIT WILL NOT BE CARRIED.
- Return tickets cost £3.50, available from RST marshals on the campsite, not on the bus.

Day 2, location 3 - Cattawade, CO11 1QW – FINISH POINT

Directions from the West: follow the B1070 through East Bergholt. Just before the roundabout for the A137 there is a turning on the right down to the Cattawade Picnic Site.

CAR PARKING and BOAT RECOVERY at CATTAWADE

Cattawade picnic site car park will be closed at dusk on Thursday 12 Sep. There is also no parking on the road leading to the picnic site.

Please instead park in Sudbury or instead park at Anglia Adventures Land slightly further up Bergholt Road - directions above. All vehicles are parked at the owners' risk. Designated car park is open: Friday 13 Sep: 17:30 to dusk / Saturday 14 Sep: 07:30 – 1000 / Sunday 15 Sep: All day.

Car access to Cattawade picnic site car park is for **<u>boat recovery only</u>** to be strictly controlled by RST marshals.

SHUTTLE SERVICE to Campsite / Sudbury

- A 16-seater mini bus will leave Cattawade at 4.30pm on Sunday to the campsite, with a second trip leaving Cattawade at 6pm to the campsite and on to the Kingfisher car park.
