

S2C 2013: DIRECTIONS & PARKING – DAY 1 (SUDBURY)

DRIVING TO: The Granary, Quay Lane Sudbury, CO10 2AN

The Granary is located next to the Quay Theatre so when entering the town of Sudbury keep an eye out for the Brown Theatre Mask signs and simply follow them.

From Colchester

On the A134 as you approach the first roundabout (with KFC on your right), continue straight over leaving the roundabout with the Esso garage on your right. Follow this road and then either:

- a) Drive straight on heading towards the Church keeping to the left lane (following signs for Chelmsford A131) and pass St. Peter's Church (on your right). Drive through town on the Market Hill keeping to the left of the HSBC bank on the corner. Continue down into Friars Street, B1115 and take the second left by the Angel Pub to drive down Quay Lane towards The Granary.
- b) Turn left to go straight over the roundabout towards Waitrose. Follow this road which bears to the right onto Station Road. AT the top of this road turn left onto Friars Street, B1115 and take the second left by the Angel Pub to drive down Quay Lane towards The Granary.

From Bury St Edmunds

On the A134 as you approach the first roundabout at the bottom of the long hill continue straight over signed Sudbury/Chelmsford A131. After just over a mile you will join the Sudbury one way system by the Masonic Hall, continue straight keeping to the right lane. Drive straight over at the traffic lights keeping to the right lane as you pass the used car garage. Follow the bend sharp right and then switch to the left lane (following signs for Chelmsford A131) and pass St. Peter's Church (on your right). Drive through town on the Market Hill keeping to the left of the HSBC bank on the corner. Continue down into Friars Street, B1115 and take the second left by the Angel Pub to drive down Quay Lane towards The Granary.

From Halstead

Enter Sudbury on the A131. As you come down Ballingdon Hill drive straight on at the traffic lights.

Option A – If Church Street is open: Just over the river bridge, turn right into Church Street (opposite Domestic Appliances shop). Follow the road around a sharp left then a sharp right bend. Follow the road passing the Cricket Ground on your right and take the second right into Quay Lane (do not pass the Angel Pub or you've gone too far!).

Option B - If Church Street is closed and diversion is still in place: Just over the river bridge, if Church Street is closed, continue straight on for ½ mile where you will be forced to turn left onto the one way system. Keep to the left lane until you have passed the traffic lights near St. Andrew's Church and then switch to the right hand lane. Follow the one way system keeping to the right over the zebra crossing passing the Masonic Hall (on your right). Keep to the right lane and drive straight over at the traffic lights still keeping to the right lane as you pass the used car garage (on your left). Follow the bend sharp right and then switch to the left lane (following signs for Chelmsford A131) and pass St. Peter's Church (on your right). Drive through town on the Market Hill keeping to the left of the HSBC bank on the corner. Continue down into Friars Street, B1115 and take the second left by the Angel Pub to drive down Quay Lane towards The Granary.

CAR PARKING AT SUDBURY

As in previous years, there is NO CAR PARKING at the Granary from Friday at 3pm and throughout Saturday morning due to lack of space. You can help to minimise traffic and congestion by:

1. Dropping off your craft/equipment on Friday evening (6pm-9pm) for overnight, secure storage at the Scout HQ or The Granary (both Quay Lane, CO10 2AN)
2. Car sharing on the day with other participants
3. Avoiding Friars Street and Quay Lane altogether by getting dropped off nearby by family/friends
4. Parking in a long stay car park near the Kingfisher Leisure Centre or Train Station and taking the 10 minute walk to the Granary (refer to the map below).

Car Parking Charges

You can park at one of the long stay car parks at Station Road (postcode CO10 2SU) near the Kingfisher Leisure Centre or Sudbury Train Station. You **MUST** display a valid ticket and the machines only accept coins (5p, 10p, 20p, 50p, £1, £2) and do not give change. The charges are as below:

Station Road Car Parking Charges (Monday-Saturday, 8am-5pm, no return within 4 hours):

0-3 hours - free

3-24 hours - £2.00

24-48 hours - £4.00

48-72 hours (max. - £6.00)

If you are arriving between 5pm-8pm the day before then you can obtain a ticket permitting you to park for 24 hours up to a maximum of 72 hours.

DRIVING TO: Station Road Car Parks *from The Granary*

Turn right at top of Quay Lane and take the next right into Station Road. Follow the road and on sharp bend turn right. You can either take first left to park in train station car park or second left to park in Kingfisher Leisure Centre car park.

WALKING TO: The Granary *from Station Road Car Parks*

Either walk down Station Road or cut across the Waitrose car park turning left into Edgworth Road. At the end of the road take the path turning right onto Bullocks Lane. Turn left onto the footpath at the end of the terraced houses and follow it to The Granary (see map on page 3).
