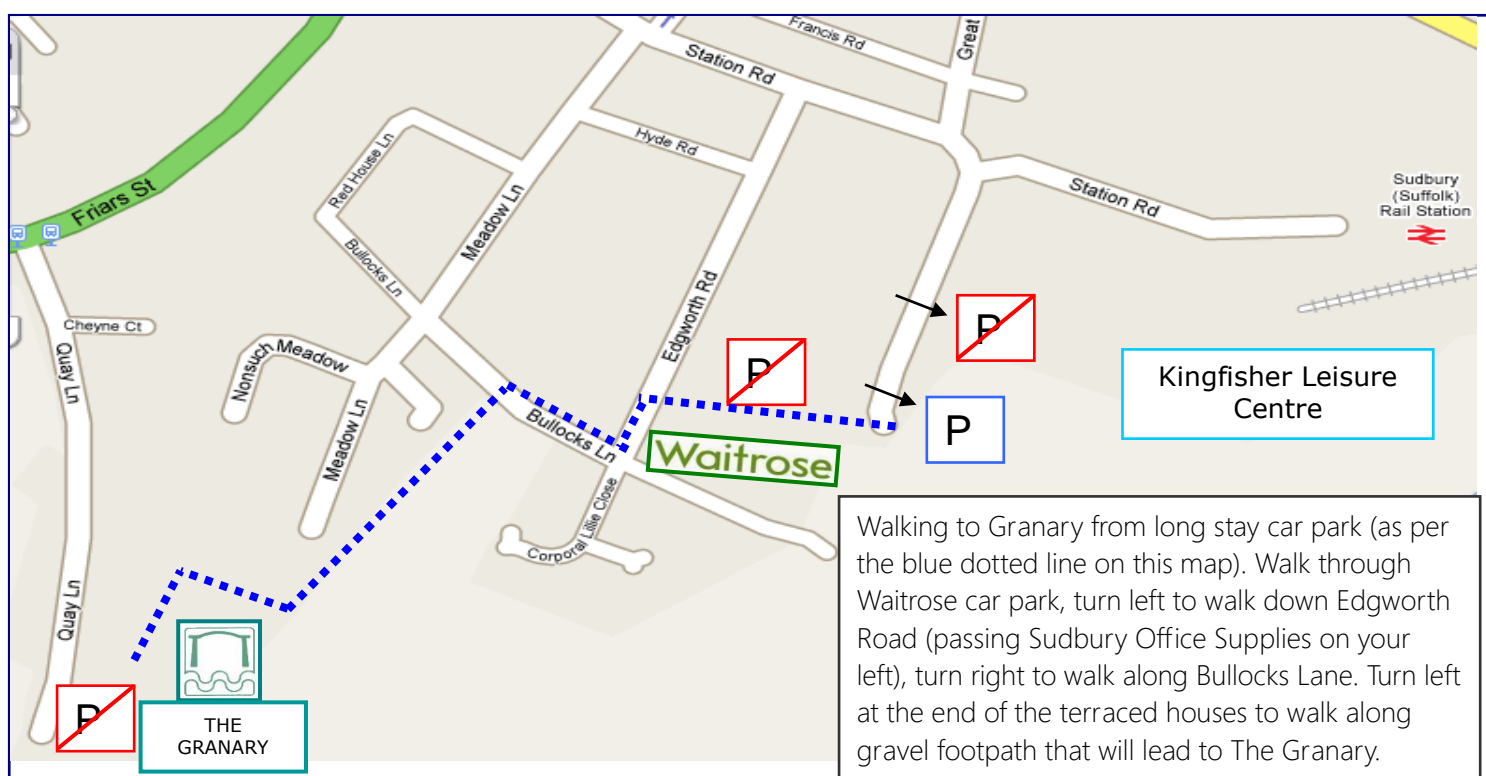
DAY 1 MEETING LOCATIONS

Day 1, location 1- The Granary, Quay Lane, CO10 2AN – STARTING POINT

As in previous years, there is NO CAR PARKING at the Granary on Saturday morning due to lack of space.

- Friday (5.30pm-9.30pm) – You are able to drop off craft for overnight and secure storage (subject to available space)
- Saturday (Day 1) – Registration (8am-10.30am)
- Saturday (Day 1) - Checkpoint & Departure (8.30am-10.30am)

Directions from Sudbury town centre: follow the signs to the Quay Theatre. You can also walk from the long stay car park near the Kingfisher Leisure Centre (see map below).



The nearest long stay car park is at Station Road Car Park (also known as Kingfisher Car Park due to its proximity of the Kingfisher Leisure Centre). Details as below or more information at:

- 297 spaces, Height Barrier: 2.2m

- Maximum Stay: 24 to 72 hours (paid tickets) and 3 hours (free tickets) during ticketing hours, otherwise 24 hours. No return within 4 hours.

- Ticketing Hours: Tickets must be displayed between 8am and 5pm Monday to Saturday (excluding Bank Holidays). Tickets can be obtained from one of six ticket machines on site. Long term parking may also be purchased via *RingGo* (follow link:

- Tariff (no charge for disabled persons, provided that a valid blue badge is on display):

Up to 3 hours – FREE / 24 hours - £2 / 48 hours - £4 / 72 hours - £6

- Payment Type: Coins (at ticket machine) or credit/debit card (via *RingGo* - location code 2537)

Day 1, location 2 - Bures Recreation Ground, CO8 5BX – DAY 1 LUNCH STOP

- Saturday (Day 1) - Checkpoint & Lunch stop (check out no later than 2.30pm)

Day 1, location 3 - Rushbanks Farm, Wissington, CO6 4NA – END OF DAY 1 & OVERNIGHT CAMPING

- Saturday (Day 1) - Checkpoint & Overnight stop
- Sunday (Day 2) – Checkpoint (check out 7.30am-10am)

Directions from Sudbury: follow the A134 towards Colchester through Leavenheath. Coming down a steep hill towards Nayland take a right turn marked Bures and Wissington (Nags Corner) the campsite is 1 mile up on the left and will be well signed.

DAY 2 MEETING LOCATIONS

Day 2, location 1 - Rushbanks Farm, Wissington, CO6 4NA – END OF DAY 1 & OVERNIGHT CAMPING

- Sunday (Day 2) – Checkpoint (check out 7.30am-10am)

Day 2, location 2 - Stratford St. Mary, CO7 6JR – DAY 2 LUNCH STOP

- Sunday (Day 2) – Checkpoint & Lunch stop (check out no later than 3pm)

Day 2, location 3 - Cattawade, CO11 1QW – FINISH POINT

- Sunday (Day 2)

Directions from the West: follow the B1070 through East Bergholt. Just before the roundabout for the A137 there is a turning on the right down to the Cattawade Picnic Site.

CAR PARKING and BOAT RECOVERY at CATTAWADE

Cattawade picnic site car park will be closed at dusk on Thursday 13 Sep.

There is also no parking on the road leading to the picnic site. Please instead park in the designated car park adjacent to the site. All vehicles are parked at the owners' risk.

Designated car park is open: Friday 14 Sep: 17:30 to dusk / Saturday 15 Sep: 07:30 – 1000 /
Sunday 16 Sep: All day.

Car access to Cattawade picnic site car park is for boat recovery only to be strictly controlled by RST marshals.
