

Rushbanks Farm Campsite at Wissington marks the halfway point and the end of the first day. S2Cers are invited to camp here overnight (unless you prefer a bed and can make it back to leave by the designated time the next morning!

FRIDAY 11 SEP For those wishing to set up on the Friday then please make yourself known to the campsite staff who will be on site from Middy that day. They will advise you on where to set up camp. There is a charge for unoccupied pitches should you set up on Friday and/or leave site until Monday.

SATURDAY 12 SEP In recognition of your sterling effort in getting this far, River Stour Trust volunteers will serve you with a free bun and a drink on arrival! Either bring along your own food to prepare and enjoy on site or pre-book somewhere local – <https://rushbankscampsite.co.uk/amenities>

SUNDAY 13 SEP We hope to have water available and fresh coffee on hand to provide a much needed dose of caffeine! Remember to have packed your breakfast because the Nayland Anchor cannot offer their usual riverside service this year. Use the toilets at the campsite before you set off because it is a long paddle until the next definite toilet stop at Stratford St Mary!

MONDAY 13 SEP There is a charge for unoccupied pitches.

The large square cow field is allocated for S2Cers DO NOT contact the campsite to book! BUT if you instead want to use the main site where campfires - using Rushbanks firepits only - are allowed or two bell tents are available to hire then the cost increases and you do need to book with them directly.

The resident campsite warden will visit you to collect camping fees – CASH ONLY!

DIRECTIONS

Rushbanks Farm, Wissington, CO6 4NA - <https://www.rushbanksfarm.co.uk/>

The farm is situated on the Suffolk side of the River Stour, between Bures and Nayland on Bures Road.

- From Colchester:

Take the A134 to Nayland. At Nayland turn left, sign posted "Bures"

Follow the road for about two kms past a left hand lane sign posted "Wissington Church." There is a group of cottages on the left and shortly after a sign to the campsite. Turn left through a gate adhering to the 10mph speed limit and follow the farm track down to the waterside.

- From Bures:

Take the B1508 to Bures. In the centre of the village turn right by the Church into Nayland Road. After 3kms look for Rushbanks Farm on the left. Another 100m turn right through a gate adhering to the 10mph speed limit and follow the farm track down to the waterside.

Campsite facilities:

- Toilet block for men and women
- Portable toilets
- Portable showers with hot water
- Play area and swings
- Chemical disposal point for caravans
- Fresh tap water
- Outdoors sink for washing dishes
- Recycling & general waste bins

Not available on site:

- Electric hook-up or WiFi (WiFi is available at all the pubs listed on the [Amenities page](#))

Campsite Terms and Conditions

- No dogs are allowed on the campsite
- NO CAMPFIRES/FIREPITS ON THE S2C CAMPSITE
- Campfires on main site only must be put out by campers before 11pm
- Only fire-pits rented from campsite are to be used
- No music or excessive noise after 11pm
- Please keep music played in the daytime at a low volume so that it does not disturb fellow campers
- Please do not use your car at the campsite between 11pm and 6am
- Please drive slowly – 5mph speed limit within the campsite and at the entrance
- Children must be supervised at all times
- Appropriate footwear should be worn at all times
- No generators, drones or Chinese lanterns allowed
- Only customers of the campsite are permitted onsite

Additional Notes:

- We reserve the right of admission to the campsite
- We expect campers staying with us to respect their fellow campers and the local environment
- Please drink carefully and mindfully whilst staying with us
- We are a family-oriented campsite which aims to provide a safe camping environment for all
- As Rushbanks Farm is within an open area in the countryside please note that the weather is changeable, please dress appropriately and be careful of uneven ground or slipping and tripping hazards
- We want everyone to enjoy their stay with us, it is an important condition that any visitor to our campsite must not excessively disturb or have any negative impact on the stay of other campers
- If any of our terms are not complied with you may be asked to leave the campsite
- No dogs since 2018 - due to irresponsible dog owners, a number of major incidents and complaints the campsite can no longer allow dogs on site. ☹️
