

S2C pitches are reserved in the top field for those choosing to camp overnight.

If you have elsewhere to stay, simply return the next morning to depart at the designated time.

Area is reserved for S2C - DO NOT contact the campsite to book!

BUT if you instead want to use the main site where campfires - using Rushbanks firepits only - are allowed or two bell tents are available to hire then you do need to book with them directly.

FRIDAY 9 SEP 2022 Access is permitted for those wishing to set up in advance for convenience (unoccupied pitch fee applies). Please adhere to the on-site signage and set up in the top field (you pass alongside it when driving down the campsite access road).

SATURDAY 10 SEP 2022 In recognition of your sterling effort, a hot drinks and buttered bun awaits you! Please let us know in advance about any food allergies or dietary requirements so can do our best to accommodate you.

Now take a moment to set up camp and either enjoy your own food on site or visit somewhere local? Rushbanks have some suggestions (<https://rushbankscampsite.co.uk/amenities>) and we are recommending The Crown at Wormingford. You can purchase a ticket for the shuttle service running trips to and from and the pub in the evening from 6:30pm (refer to our **SHUTTLE SERVICE** document).

Later on, 'Sunset Corner' at the campsite offers a great view of...the sunset! – it's located on the riverbank by the showers & swings.

SATURDAY EVENING CAMPERS - PLEASE REMEMBER:

If you are at the campsite, please be considerate and do not disturb, perturb or any other type of 'urb' your fellow campers!

SUNDAY 11 SEP 2022 The wonderful Queen Bee will have fresh, proper coffee on hand to provide that dose of caffeine. You can also pre-order food for brekky and/or lunch (see **QUEEN BEE MENU**). - *From Colchester:* Take the A134 to Nayland. At Nayland turn left, sign posted 'Bures'. Follow the road for about 2km past a left hand lane sign posted 'Wissington Church'. There is a group of cottages on the left and shortly after a sign to the campsite. Turn left through a gate, adhering to the 5mph speed limit, and follow the farm track down to the waterside.
- *From Bures:* Take the B1508 to Bures. In the centre of the village turn right by the church into Nayland Road. After 3km look for Rushbanks Farm on the left. Another 100m turn right through a gate, adhering to the 5mph speed limit, and follow the farm track down to the waterside.

Campsite facilities:

- Toilet block for men and women
- Portable toilets
- Portable showers with hot water
- Play area and swings
- Chemical disposal point for caravans
- Fresh tap water
- Outdoors sink for washing dishes
- Recycling & general waste bins

[Not available: Electric hook-up or WiFi]

Campsite Terms and Conditions

- Sorry, no dogs are allowed on the campsite
- NO CAMPFIRES/FIREPITS ON THE S2C CAMPSITE
- Campfires on main site only must be put out by campers before 11pm
- Only fire-pits rented from campsite are to be used
- No music or excessive noise after 11pm
- Your music must not be heard beyond your pitch so that it does not disturb fellow campers
- Please do not use your car at the campsite between 11pm and 6am
- Please drive slowly – 5mph speed limit within the campsite and at the entrance
- Children must be supervised at all times
- Appropriate footwear should be worn at all times
- No generators, drones or Chinese lanterns allowed
- Only customers of the campsite are permitted onsite

Additional Notes:

- We reserve the right of admission to the campsite
- We expect campers staying with us to respect their fellow campers and the local environment
- Please drink carefully and mindfully whilst staying with us
- We are a family-oriented campsite which aims to provide a safe camping environment for all
- As Rushbanks Farm is within an open area in the countryside please note that the weather is changeable, please dress appropriately and be careful of uneven ground or slipping and tripping hazards
- We want everyone to enjoy their stay with us, it is an important condition that any visitor to our campsite must not excessively disturb or have any negative impact on the stay of other campers
- If any of our terms are not complied with you may be asked to leave the campsite
- No dogs since 2018 - due to irresponsible dog owners, a number of major incidents and complaints the campsite can no longer allow dogs on site. ☹️
