- 1. Minutes of last meeting. Approved.
- 2. Matters arising In the absence of any contact from the IWA JL wants Graham Gardner to be approved as an assessor. Agreed. The EA contractor, Aquatic Solutions, has cut the weeds from Sudbury to Henny, between 1st 4th August, in time for the Sudbury Regatta. 4 machines 1 cutter, 3 collectors. They then went down to Cattawade and found the oxygen levels in the water were too low, so they had to stop. The EA are going to try and oxygenate the water. Suggested RST should look into the option of paying to have this work done ourselves in the future.

3. Reports

- **a. Financial** Written report from Lisa. Annual accounts have been circulated for discussion. MF commented that there was no mention of his donation of a workboat worth £1000.
- **b. AGM** Should be sometime in October. It was agreed the Zoom format works well.
