

INFORMATION FOR S2C CAMPING

There is no need to book a pitch with Rushbanks Farm as the booking (not the payment) is covered with your S2C booking if you're staying on the main S2C camping field.

You will need to pay for the pitch in cash upon arrival as outlined below.

Please note: No dogs are allowed on site

Option 1

- Your pitch is reserved – no booking required!
- You will need to pay £15 per pitch in cash upon arrival on the main S2C camping field.
- Campfires from us will not be provided in this field.

Option 2

- If you would like to be located on the main campsite then normal fees are charged.
- Campfires will be provided by us in this area. Therefore, only the main campsite will allow campfires provided by us.

BELOW IS A LIST OF OUR TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Dogs are not allowed at the campsite
- There must be a 6 metre gap between pitches for fire regulations
- We only permit the use of fire pits provided by us
- All fire pits must be extinguished by **23.00**
- No music or excessive noise after **23.00**
- Your daytime music must not be heard beyond your pitch
- Please do not use your car at the campsite between 23.00 and 06.00
- Please drive slowly, we have a speed limit of 5mph within the campsite and at the entrance
- Children must be supervised at all times
- Appropriate footwear should be worn at all times
- No generators, drones or chinese lanterns are allowed
- Only our customers are permitted at the campsite

Please Note:

- We reserve the right of admission to the campsite
- We expect campers staying with us to respect their fellow campers and the local environment
- Please drink carefully and mindfully whilst staying with us
- We are a family oriented campsite which aims to provide a safe camping environment for all
- As Rushbanks Campsite is within an open area in the countryside please note that the weather is changeable, please dress appropriately and be careful of uneven ground or slipping and tripping hazards
- We want everyone to enjoy their stay with us, it is an important condition that any visitor to our campsite must not excessively disturb or have any negative impact on the stay of other campers
- If any of our terms are not complied with you may be asked to leave the campsite
