

MAIN LOCATIONS – FOOD & DRINK - TOILETS

Below is an overview of the main locations – addresses, times and facilities (food, drink and toilets!)

FRIDAY 8 Sep - 4:30pm-7:30pm - The Granary, Quay Lane, Sudbury, CO10 2AN

You might find it helpful to drop off your craft and equipment for overnight storage in the Scout HQ (overspill can be stored on Granary decking area). Our volunteers will greet you. Please be careful driving down Quay Lane as it can be quite tight. Toilets available in Granary.

FRIDAY 8 Sep - Rushbanks Farm Campsite, Bures Road, Wissington, Suffolk, CO6 4NA

You can pitch up to camp tonight and/or Saturday night. Or simply leave a vehicle ready for your arrival on Saturday. Please only use the Top Field which is designated for S2C (it's the area alongside the campsite access road). Adhere to on-site signage. Toilets on site.

SATURDAY 9 Sep – 8am-10am Event Registration – The Granary, Quay Lane, Sudbury, CO10 2AN ***10.30am checkout deadline***

You are being allocated a launch time slot to help us manage the flow of traffic and participants! We ask that you arrive no earlier than 10 minutes before your designated launch time slot. We are selling hot drinks and bacon butties. We can fill up your water bottles too, Toilets available in Granary.

Please be careful driving down Quay Lane as it can be quite tight. Our volunteers will direct you and we must ask vehicles to leave the car park after drop off to avoid congestion. The nearest long stay car park is Station Road Car Park (AKA Kingfisher Car Park). Or vehicles are permitted to park at the finish point (please only use the Top Field which is designated for S2C – it's located alongside the campsite access road – follow on site signage).

It's about 3 hours paddling before the Bures checkpoint & lunch stop.

SATURDAY Checkpoint & Lunch – Bures Recreation Ground, Nayland Rd, Bures, CO8 5BX ***2.30pm checkout deadline***

A veritable bounty of treats awaits you! Vitalina's Icecreams will be about and the Bures Farmers Market is taking place 10am-1pm on Bures Common (a very short walk away from the recreation ground). Here you will find fabulous local farm produce, drinks and bakery goodies. Food stalls includes Totham Bangers (burgers and hot dogs) and Mena's Indian Banquet (samosas, bahjis, etc), several stalls selling baked goods such as sausage rolls and cakes as well as fruit and veg to eat on the go! The Bures WI will be there selling lovely cakes and supporting the Clean Rivers Campaign. Hot and cold drinks are available in the barn. Several small shops and pubs in the village.

There is a small, free car park adjacent to the recreation ground (also nearest road exit). There is a portaloos toilet here in the car park or you can use the toilet facilities on Bures Common.

SATURDAY 9 Sep - Finish Checkpoint at Rushbanks Farm Campsite, CO6 4NA

Your hot drink, bun and finisher's certificate is awaiting collection! Please let us know in advance about any food allergies or dietary requirements so can do our best to accommodate you.

Toilets on site.

SUNDAY 10 Sep - Rushbanks Farm Campsite, CO6 4NA

Make sure to pre-order breakfast pastries before the deadline although there could be some spare treats (Queen Bee menu is signposted on the campsite toilets!).
