This year's finish point will be at Wissington near Nayland, specifically Rushbanks Farm Campsite, which is our usual finish point for the 'normal' S2C. You can camp overnight in the pre-arranged S2C camping zone and have the option of taking to the water again whenever you like the next day.

S2C CAMPING / PARKING AREA IS TOP FIELD ONLY FOLLOW ON-SITE SIGNAGE!

(Top Field is the area alongside the campsite access road)

OPTION 1 - S2C Camping Area

Your pitch is pre-arranged - do not call to book!
Camping pitches for all participants has been pre-arranged with an area allocated for the event.
You will need to cash to pay the pitch fee to the campsite warden.
Campfires are not permitted in this field

OPTION 2 - Main Campsite

If you would like to be located on the main campsite (where campsite provided firepits are permitted) then normal fees are charged and you will need to book directly with the campsite:

The resident campsite warden will visit to collect camping fees – CASH ONLY!

Campsite warden will visit your pitch after 16.00 to check you in and tag your accommodation

S2C Top Field – reserved for you! S2C Event Pitch Charges

DO NOT contact the campsite to book!

- Area is reserved for S2C
- No campfires allowed

Pitch fee for tent/camper/caravan

- £15 per occupied
- £7.50 per unoccupied

Main Campsite – bookings only Standard Pitch Charges

Their main campsite is bookable for those who would like a campfire (Rushbanks firepits only).
Book directly with Rushbanks for place on their main campsite (as opposed to reserved pitch on top field for S2C event). Make sure to mention S2C during booking process.
