## EVENT START POINT - THE GRANARY, CO10 2AN (8:00am-10:00am)



The registration will open at 8am and everyone is allocated a launch time. The Entry List is compiled ahead of the event and confirms Saturday time slots and entry number for each craft. It is ordered alphabetically by Primary Paddler surname.

Registration requires the Primary Paddler to confirm details for the craft entry (participant names, onboard mobile and emergency contact) as well as present proof of how the craft is registered for navigational use on the river. Affix your entry number sticker to your craft in a place that will be visible to the riverside checkpoint marshals.

Grab a hot drink, bacon (or vegi sausage) sandwich and comfort break. Set off via the jetty next to the slipway. S2C Sweepers will follow you and do their best to help if you have a problem.



### Great Cornard

Portage and Lock are on the left fork past the weir. The lock will be operated for a limited period. Treat weir with caution, beware of the side jet at high water levels.



**Henny Weir** Portage on the left via platforms. This weir should be treated with caution at all levels. **DO NOT SHOOT THE WEIR - THERE IS A FALLEN WILLOW THAT WILL TRAP YOU AT THE BOTTOM!** Do **NOT** enter the Mill Pool straight ahead - strictly private! Please do not stop at the Henny Swan - it's far too soon into the journey for stopping and you need to get to Bures in time for lunchtime treats at the Farmer's Market and to leave the checkpoint on time!



**Henny Regulator** 0.5 metre drop, portage on the left bank.



**Pitmire (Daws Hall)** Landing stage on left. Carry around weir to launch from the landing stage. Take left hand channel below portage. Beware of concrete block immediately after the footbridge. The right bank is a nature reserve - strictly private!



**Lamarsh Regulator** Portage on left, via platforms.

## BURES RECREATION GROUND, CO8 5BX \*DEPART BY 2:30PM\*



Exit via landing stage on the left-hand bank. **Please check in before stopping for lunch!**



A veritable bounty of treats awaits you! Vitalina's Icecreams will be about and the Bures Farmers Market is taking place 10am-1pm on Bures Common (a very short walk away from the recreation ground). Food stalls selling hot and cold, savoury and sweet until 1pm. Bures WI selling cakes and supporting Clean Rivers Campaign. Hot and cold drinks available in the barn as are toilet facilities.



Several small shops and pubs in the village. A small, free car park is adjacent (with portaloos) and is the nearest road exit. **Check out no later than 2:30pm deadline.**



**Bures Mill** Do not use the impassable fish bypass 100 metres upstream of the portage. Portage at platform on the right and over bank. Avoid the sluice at all costs.



**Wormingford Mill** Portage is accessed by taking the right fork before the weir to the landing stage. Follow fenced path through private garden. Steps and lower jetty may be slippery. Do not pass through the old lock chamber as this is highly dangerous.
