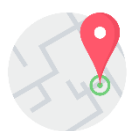
Tea Room is open to offer breakfast sandwiches (bacon or vegi sausage), hot / cold drinks, and can fill water bottles.

PARKING – very limited in the Quay Lane area and we also want to avoid congestion. The nearest long stay is at Friars Meadow Car Park (CO10 2SS - W3W///[audit.crunching.inert](https://www.audit.crunching.inert)). Parking fee applies Mon-Sat, 8am- 6pm and you can pay in person using the machines or via [MiPermit mobile app](https://www.mipermit.co.uk) (location code: 747101).

Alternatively, if you can sort the logistics, you can park at Rushbanks Campsite in the Top Field alongside the campsite access road – follow on site signage.

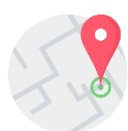

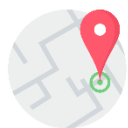
Queen Bee Coffee is back this year! Hurrah 😊
