

SATURDAY REGISTRATION PROCESS

Please check your allocated time for registration and launching

8am-8:30am | 8:30am-9am | 9am-9:30am | 9:30am-10am You can arrive 10 mins earlier – Tea Room will be open from 8am selling hot drinks £1.50 and bacon or vegi sausage sandwiches £3.50

You need to verify 5 key details:

- 1. Primary Paddler name (entries are sorted alphabetically by surname)
- 2. Name of any additional participants
- 3. Onboard mobile number
- **4.** Emergency contact name & number
- 5. Provide proof of valid waterways licence any of the following:
 - Paddle UK 'on the water' membership (at least one person in the craft)
 - Environment Agency craft registration (per craft)
 - Event ticket option with 'S2C Paddle Pass' (per craft)
 - Event ticket option with craft hire (S2C official hire partner)

Please note: Any entry determined to be without valid and acceptable proof of a waterways licence at any point during the event must purchase a 'paddle pass' - £15.50 per craft. This is refundable (less £3 admin fee) should valid and acceptable proof of alternative registration be presented within 3 days after the event.

Once entry details are verified:

- Each craft has a unique craft entry number. This is used to monitor your successful progress along the route.
- You need to know your number for the checkpoint locations (Bures, Wissington, Stratford St Mary and Cattawade).
- Please apply your craft sticker so it is visible from bankside.
- Every participant gets a wristband why not add your craft entry number?
