****S2C area is reserved - do not call to book!****

S2C Pitch Fees (tent/camper/caravan)

- £25 per occupied pitch (i.e. staying overnight)
- £12.50 per unoccupied pitch (i.e. Friday set up only - not sleeping overnight)
 - Fee applies whether the pitch is occupied or not.

Other Fees

- £6 per dog (must be kept on leads and cleaned up after)
- £8 for a Firepit and Grill
- £10 for a bag of wood plus kindling and firelighters

Please note:

- Your pitch is pre-arranged - **do not call to book!**
- S2C camping pitches have been pre-arranged in an area allocated for the event.
- Only campfires provided by campsite are allowed until 11pm
- Dogs permitted (charge applies)
- **CASH ONLY!** The campsite warden will visit to check you in and tag your accommodation.

ALTERNATIVE CAMPING IN ADJACENT MAIN CAMPSITE AREA

- Pitch fees start at £36

 - You could mention participation in S2C during booking process.

FRIDAY 11 SEPTEMBER 2026

- Access is permitted for those wishing to set up in advance for convenience (pitch fee applies whether you are staying there or not).
- Please adhere to the on-site signage and set up in the top field (you pass alongside it when driving down the campsite access road).

SATURDAY 12 SEPTEMBER 2026

- A cuppa and cookie for all paddlers upon arrival. Please let us know in advance about any food allergies or dietary requirements so can do our best to accommodate you.
