

In preparation for this upcoming weekend, our volunteers undertook a comprehensive survey of the river conditions. Water levels across the country are very low, and a number of canals and rivers have been subject to restrictions and closures as a result.

We are very disappointed to inform you the very low water levels and rapid weed and reed growth between Rushbanks Campsite and Boxted make the route almost impassable.

Our highest priority is to ensure that S2C remains an enjoyable and safe event for everyone. We have reluctantly decided that it is not possible for this year's event to go ahead as originally planned.

YOUR OPTIONS

- **1-Day Mini S2C:** We can run a one-day event ending at Rushbanks Campsite on Saturday, but we need a minimum number of entries to make it happen. We will arrange a partial refund based on entry fee adjustments.
- **Full Cancellation:** If you do not want to take part in the 1-day Mini S2C or it doesn't happen, we can of course arrange a full refund.
