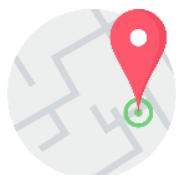

DROP OFF ONLY! Very limited in Quay Lane and need space for safe manoeuvrability of craft and people!



ALTERNATIVE SUGGESTIONS - Nearest long stay is Friars Meadow Car Park (CO10 2SS). Parking fee applies Mon-Sat, 8am-6pm.

Or, if you can arrange getting back to Sudbury for Saturday morning, you can park at Rushbanks Campsite - follow onsite signage.



8am-9:30am (time slots are allocated to ease congestion)

You can arrive 10 minutes earlier than your allocated time slot.

Entries are identified by Primary Paddler Surname.

You must be ready to verify craft entry details before launching:

- Participant names for each craft entry
- Ages of children and name of responsible adult (same craft or paddling alongside?)
- Onboard mobile number
- Emergency contact
- Proof of your valid waterways licence (unless Fluidity craft hire or need 'S2C Paddle Pass').



We'll be selling bacon and vegi sausage sandwiches alongside hot and cold drinks. We can fill your water bottles.



Toilets available in Granary and Scout HQ (nearby green building)

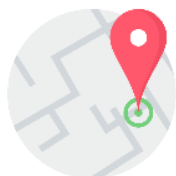

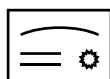

- **Anyone deemed over the alcohol limit will not be carried.**

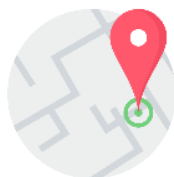

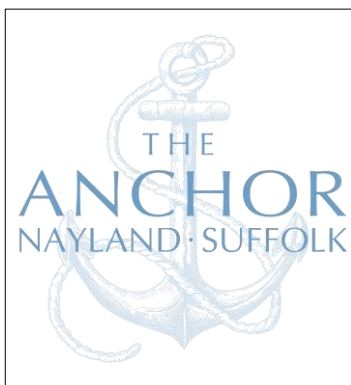
